WELCOME

The development and delivery of Newcastle Great Park is led by the NGP Consortium, that comprises national home builders, Persimmon Homes and Taylor Wimpey. Work began on the site in 2001; delivering essential growth for the city of Newcastle.

DELIVERED *to date*

1800+ HOMES

Over 1800 family homes have been delivered, 260 of which were in 2015, this represents over 27% of the city's housing growth!

PLAY AREAS

3 play areas have been delivered.

OFFICE SPACE

Over two thousand staff working on site.

OPEN SPACE

Over 200 acres of open space, including a range of walking and cycling routes.

DEDICATED BUS

The park is served by a dedicated bus service, the Q3.

SCHOOLS & COMMUNITY FACILITIES

Brunton First School, Brunton Day Nursery and a community centre with outdoor space and playing fields.



WHAT WORK *is ongoing*

FAMILY HOMES

Continue to be delivered at the current rate.

TOWN CENTRE

Work has begun on the town centre and we are working hard to secure retailer occupation in 2017.

OPEN SPACE

Footpaths and cycleways are being completed, linking all parts of the park.

PLAY AREAS

Further play areas are under construction.

SPINE ROAD

The spine road will be constructed providing a second access from the park to the A1, linking the existing road at SAGE to Kingston Park Road.

WHAT WORK *is next*

Work will continue as planned with changes proposed to the land north and west of Sage. Land previously proposed for commercial use will be developed for housing, new schools and playing fields.
